Haiti Feeding Program



I just recently returned from Port-au-Prince Haiti where I spent 4 days checking on the feeding project and speaking at a couple of meetings.

It was a very good trip and while I was waiting for JB, our Haiti representative to pick me up at the airport, a young man began to talk to me. We were talking about the horrible situation in Haiti. (If you EVER think you have it bad in America, PLEASE, PLEASE, PLEASE GO TO HAITI FOR A WEEK. You will really appreciate your life here.)

The young man I met was a believer and I asked him if he was filled with the HOLY SPIRIT and he answered no. I gave him a 3 minute course on why he needed to be filled and be able to pray in the spirit. He was excited to hear this GOOD NEWS and by the time JB drove up a few minutes later my new friend was praying in his prayer language. Hallelujah! What a way to start the trip!

While there I was also able to speak several times to a group of ladies about being new creatures in Christ. The report we received afterwards is that it gave them hope. That is so exciting to us, to be able to share Jesus and hope. Fifteen or so were baptized in the Holy Spirit and learned much that they said they hadn't heard before. There is a great need for extended teaching there.

JB and Larry delivered the funds for the feeding project and they were able to buy the food needed for

distribution to the people. We were able to feed 90 people for a month with \$1,000. There is now a waiting list of people wanting to be a part of the program, the need there is so huge.

After not having been there for about a year I was still shocked at the level of poverty. It seemed to be getting worse instead of better.

The people that work with us in Haiti on behalf of Encompass Ministries are such great people. They give help to those who truly cannot help themselves. We are working on starting an English program in the city that would help support these people.

If you looked at Haiti in the natural you would say there is no way to help, this country is hopeless, helpless, and lifeless...kind of like you and I before Christ came in.

WITH GOD ALL THINGS ARE POSSIBLE and I have to see Haiti by the spirit, by faith, and in the completed work of Christ. The spirit of God is at work in Haiti and we will stand for its complete deliverance and freedom.

We are prayerfully considering a pastor's training conference for next year. We want to encourage evangelism but at the same time there is a big need for training and teaching.
